

Norfolk Heritage Park Sculpture Trail

Take a stroll round Norfolk Heritage Park and spot the sculptures along the way.

1. Sculptural Seats

Artist – Gillian Brent (1999) and local senior school children. This sculpture was created as part of Sheffield Children’s Festival.

2. Norfolk Heritage Park Mosaic

Artists - Katie O’Neill and Coralie Turpin (1999) and local school children. This sculpture was created as part of Sheffield Children’s Festival to celebrate the park.

3. Deer and Troll

Artist - Robin Dobson (2008) and children from Norfolk Community Primary School. This sculpture was created because this park used to be part of the medieval deer park and also because the children believe there is a troll living under the bridge in Jervis Lum.



4. Green Woman

Artist - Andrew Vickers (2007). This sculpture represents spring and new life.

5. Insect Way-marker

Artist - Jason Thompson (1995). This sculpture was created as part of the original nature trail through Jervis Lum and this is the only part that remains.

6. Story Stone

Artist - Andrew Vickers (2002) and local community members. This sculpture was created to inspire people to sit round this quiet area and share stories.

7. Guardian of the Woods

Artist - Andrew Vickers (2007). This sculpture protects the woods at night!

8. Kestrel

Artist - Gillian Brent (2002/03) working on ‘The Learning Network’ project with non-school attendees.

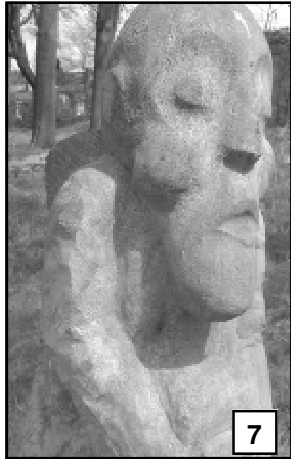
9. Sundial Mosaic

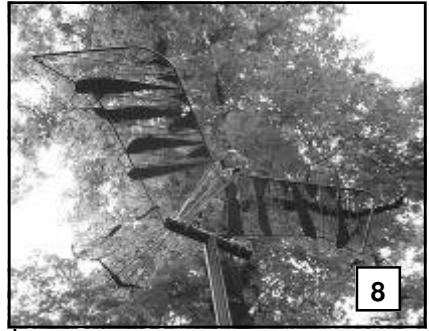
Where to find the sculptures in the park:

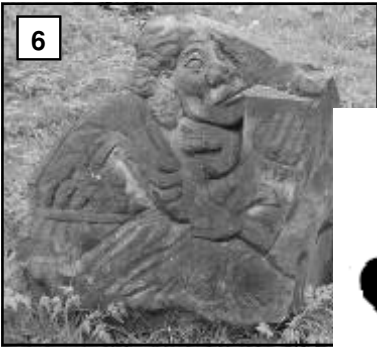

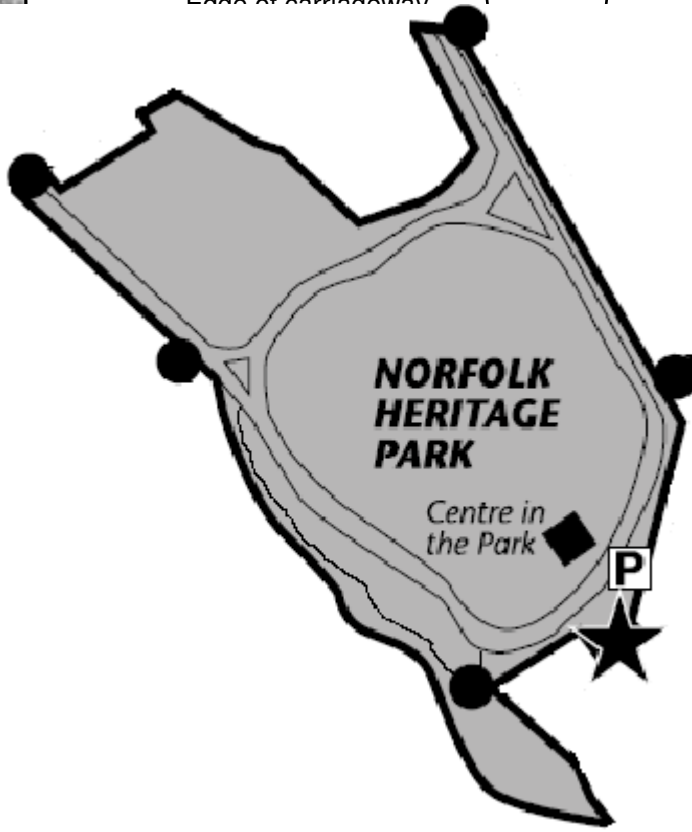

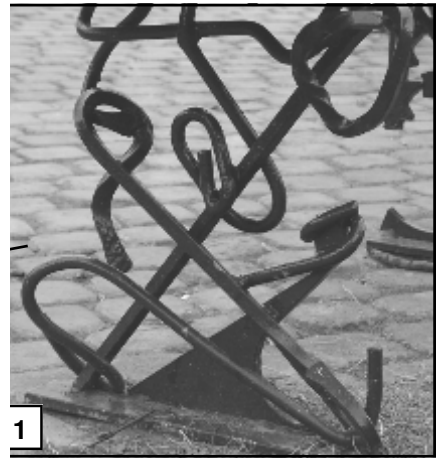

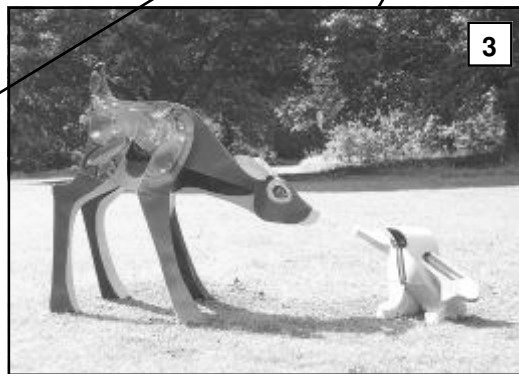
